

Aerangis biloba



Native of: Central and East Africa

Habitat: Epiphytic in forest, woodland and thicket from sea level to 700m.

Description: small plant with medium white flowers with a pinkish spur. Plants are free flowering with up to 12 flowers on a stem and first flowering can be within a year from deflasking.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light.

Flowering season: early summer & again in late autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 1-2yrs
