

Aerangis brachycarpa



Native of: Widespread in tropical Africa

Habitat: Epiphytic at low level on tree trunks in shade in upland forest from 1500 to 2300m

Description: small plant with 25cm leaves arching flower stems carrying up to 12 flowers which are white 5cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it warm (min15°C) in low light but its range implies it could grow cooler.

Flowering season: Autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 2-3 yrs
