

# Aerangis confusa



**Native of:** Kenya & Tanzania

**Habitat:** At low level on tree trunks in shade, mostly in hilly areas 1600 to 2100 m.

**Description:** small plant with medium white flowers with a pink tinge. From 4 to 10 flowers on each stem.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light.

**Flowering season:** early summer & again in late autumn

**Flask to flowering approx:** 2yrs
